When I went to my county to ask for help, I had little to no help. When I got "some help," I was given the wrong information, time ran out, and my family was kicked out. I had no time to even challenge the mistake made. Ultimately, I and my family paid the price.

There are many people out there like me. This is why expediting rental assistance programs would be key in helping many people. This is a great bill, and I could have used it during my own time of need.

Madam Chair, Committee let us take care of our people. Let us get S.F 4704 done.
