On behalf of the Long-Term Care Imperative, which represents over 2,000 providers across the long-term care continuum, we thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on SF4191/HF3654.

We appreciate that we had an opportunity to meet with your offices prior to this bill's introduction and ensure that we were meeting shared goals and objectives to fairly balance consumer transparency with provider capacity. While the requirements in the proposed bill would be new for assisted living providers, the language proposed in SF 4191/HF 3654 is consistent with what is already required for nursing homes. We appreciate that this bill also permits providers to provide a copy upon request.

We do not have concerns with the bill as introduced, and thank you for the opportunity to work with you in service of Minnesota's growing demographic of seniors.
