

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS4399A-3)
1.2 to S.F. No. 4399 as follows:

1.3 Page 15, after line 19, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 15. Minnesota Statutes 2023 Supplement, section 256B.4914, subdivision 10d, is
1.5 amended to read:

1.6 Subd. 10d. **Direct care staff; compensation.** (a) A provider paid with rates determined
1.7 under subdivision 6 must use a minimum of 66 percent of the revenue generated by rates
1.8 determined under that subdivision for direct care staff compensation and technology costs.

1.9 (b) A provider paid with rates determined under subdivision 7 must use a minimum of
1.10 45 percent of the revenue generated by rates determined under that subdivision for direct
1.11 care staff compensation and technology costs.

1.12 (c) A provider paid with rates determined under subdivision 8 or 9 must use a minimum
1.13 of 60 percent of the revenue generated by rates determined under those subdivisions for
1.14 direct care staff compensation and technology costs.

1.15 (d) Compensation under this subdivision includes:

1.16 (1) wages;

1.17 (2) taxes and workers' compensation;

1.18 (3) health insurance;

1.19 (4) dental insurance;

1.20 (5) vision insurance;

1.21 (6) life insurance;

1.22 (7) short-term disability insurance;

1.23 (8) long-term disability insurance;

1.24 (9) retirement spending;

1.25 (10) tuition reimbursement;

1.26 (11) wellness programs;

1.27 (12) paid vacation time;

1.28 (13) paid sick time; or

1.29 (14) other items of monetary value provided to direct care staff.

- 2.1 (e) Technology costs under this subdivision include:
- 2.2 (1) costs related to providing remote support, including payments made to third-party
- 2.3 vendors; or
- 2.4 (2) cost of technology to support individuals remotely."

- 2.6 Amend the title accordingly
