1.10 technology must occur within 30 business days of the receipt of the initial request. If denied,

1.13 individual's assessed need.

1.15 to read:

1.16 Subd. 16b. **Authorization of technology services.** (a) Lead agencies must not implement
1.17 additional requirements, in addition to those required by the commissioner, that could result
1.18 in the delay of approval or implementation of technology.

1.19 (b) For individuals receiving waiver services under this section, approval or denial of
1.20 technology must occur within 30 business days of the receipt of the initial request. If denied,
1.21 the lead agency must submit a notice of action form clearly stating the reason for the denial,
1.22 including information describing why the technology is not appropriate to meet the
1.23 individual's assessed need. "
