1 and 2	<b>SF 3839-1E</b> (Boldon)	Exempts certain small, assisted living facilities and certain 245D licensed residential programs from local rental licensing regulations.
3 to 7	<b>SF 3734</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Utke)	Modifies home and community-based service standards under chapter 245D related to timelines for initial planning meetings, education requirements for certain service coordinators and service managers, and the age of staff who may administer medications.
8 and 9	<b>SF 4173</b> (Fateh)	Modifies the educational and prior experience requirements for certain providers of positive supports.
10, 12 to 20 and 22	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to reporting HCBS service suspensions and terminations;
11	<b>SF 4197</b> (Maye Quade)	Modifies the circumstances under which an MA-EPD premium is redetermined.
<del>12 to 17</del>	<del><b>SF 4955</b> (Abeler)</del>	<del><b>Modifies provisions related to the frequency and assessment tools used for reassessments for long-term services and supports (aka MnCHOICES reassessments)</b></del>
16	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to permitting remote reassessments for PCA and CFSS
18 and 19	A modified version of portions of <b>SF 3736</b> (Rasmusson)	Requires lead agencies to approve or disapprove the use of technology under the disability waivers using only standards developed by the commissioner, and it denied to provide an explanation of the denial.
20	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to prioritizing the use of technology under the disability waivers.

21	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to standardizing data collection for disability rate setting purposes.
22	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to clarifying the definition of “eating” for the purposes of the CFSS program.
23 to 25, 27, and 29	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to transferring the responsibility to approve CFSS delivery plans from consultation service providers to lead agencies.
26	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contains provisions from the DHS policy bill related to providing an exception to the 30-day required notice prior to terminating financial management services under the CFSS program.
28	<b>SF 3991</b> (Baldon)	Allows worker training and development services in the CFSS program to be provided remotely.
30	<b>SF 4399-A20</b> (Abeler)	Modifying provisions related to the duties of DHS relative to the Waiver Reimagine Advisory Taskforce
<b>31</b>	<del><b>SF 4268</b> as amended by the A1 (Kupiec)</del>	<del><b>Permitting assistive technology partnerships between providers and lead agencies to expedite authorizations of technology under the disability waivers.</b></del>
32	<b>4399-A21</b> (Abeler)	Providing an exception to the customized living age and size limitations for Clare Housing.

1 to 16	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Modernizes the Deaf and Hard of Hearing Services Act.
17	<b>SF 4478-1E</b> (Hoffman)	Modifies the composition of the Commission on the Deaf, Deafblind, and Hard of Hearing.  In State and Local Government and Veterans

1	<b>SF 4457</b> as amended by the A1 (Abeler)	Modifies the requirements for assisted living director licensure.
2, 10 to 23, and 25	<b>SF 4044-1E</b> (Hoffman)	Expands the consumer protections that apply to settings exempt from assisted living licensure.
3	<b>SF 4191</b> (Housley)	Requires public posting of assisted living correction plans.
4 and 25	<b>SF 4329-1E</b> (Rasmusson)	Modifies procedures related to long-term care options counseling for potential assisted living residents and hospital patients at risk of nursing home placement.  Second Reading
5	<b>SF 792</b> as amended by the A2 (Fateh)	Provides for continuity of care for older adults receiving personal care services when the individual changes managed care plans.
6, 7 and 25	<b>SF 4580-1E</b> (Hoffman)	Requires nursing facility owners and operators to report certain related-party transactions.  Second Reading
8 and 9	<b>SF 4399-A4</b> (Abeler)	Clarifies the timeline for sunseting the rate floor for certain settings serving a high proportion of individuals on the elderly waiver.
24	<b>SF 3625</b> (Seeberger)	Limits rent increases in certain low-income senior rental projects receiving low-income housing tax credits.  Laid over in Housing and Homelessness Prevention

1, <del>11</del> , 24, 29 and 30	<b>SF 3984</b> as amended by the A3 (with a grammatical correction), sections 1 to 4 (Abeler)	Modify alcohol and drug counselor education requirements, expands permissible accrediting bodies for alternative licensing inspections of substance use disorder treatment facilities, and clarifies provisions related to span of eligibility for services reimbursed by the Behavioral health fund.

2 to 5, 12, 14, 22, 28, 29, 31, 32, 34, 35, and 36	<b>SF 4399</b> as amended by the A1 and A2 (Hoffman)	Contain provisions for the DHS policy bill related to substance use disorder services
<del>6 to 10, 13, 15 to 21, and 23</del>	<del>SF4399-A17 (Abeler)</del>	<del>Adds a definition of “qualified professional” to the statutes governing licensing of substance use disorder facilities and makes conforming changes.</del>
25 to 27 and 37	<b>SF 4104</b> as amended by the A1 (Kupec)	Modifies provisions related to unsupervised use of opioid use disorder medications.
32	<b>SF 4399-A16</b> (Hoffman)	Clarifies existing base rate for medium intensity SUD services
33	<b>SF 3973</b> as amended by the A1 (Mann)	Modifies provisions related to sober homes, particularly the use of legally prescribed medications.
