S.F. No. 3441 - Eliminating exception for domestic abuse advocate testimony

Under current law, a domestic abuse advocate may not be compelled to disclose any opinion or information received from a victim without the victim's consent. Current law provides an exception for the court to compel disclosure after weighing certain factors. **S.F. 3441** eliminates the exception and clarifies that a domestic abuse advocate is not allowed to disclose any opinion or information which the advocate acquired while attending to the victim in their professional capacity.

This bill is effective July 1, 2024.
