On behalf of Hospitality Minnesota, we would like to thank Senator Mohamed and HOME Line for working in collaboration with us to understand the impacts to hospitality in the initial draft of SF3492/HF3591, which inserted hotels, motels and lodging into landlord and tenant rights under 504B. Hospitality Minnesota is the state trade association that represents the restaurants and food service, hotels and lodging, campground and resort sectors.

We are grateful to Senator Mohamed and HOME Line for understanding that initially placing hotels, motels and lodging into 504B landlord and tenant rights posed challenges within existing hotel, motel and lodging regulations from a health, safety and compliance perspective. We appreciate the amendment to strike hotels, motels and lodging that passed the Senate Housing and Homelessness Prevent Committee.

From a hospitality perspective, we have no further concerns regarding SF 3492/HF 3591.
