

1.1 **Senator Latz from the Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety, to which was**  
1.2 **re-referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 3496:** A bill for an act relating to labor; providing compensation for minors  
1.4 appearing in Internet content creation; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 181A.03,  
1.5 by adding subdivisions; 181A.07, subdivision 2; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota  
1.6 Statutes, chapter 181A.

1.7 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.8 Page 1, after line 6, insert:

1.9 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 181A.03, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.10 Subdivision 1. **General.** As used in sections 181A.01 to ~~181A.12~~ 181A.13, the terms  
1.11 defined in this section shall have the following meanings."

1.12 Page 2, delete section 4

1.13 Page 3, delete lines 28 to 32

1.14 Page 4, delete lines 1 to 6

1.15 Page 4, line 7, delete "Civil cause of action; violations" and insert "Civil action;  
1.16 enforcement" and delete "If a content creator whose content features" and insert "(a) If a  
1.17 content creator knowingly or recklessly violates this section, a minor or a person who was  
1.18 a minor at the time of the alleged violation may commence a civil action to enforce the  
1.19 provisions of this section regarding the trust account. In any action brought in accordance  
1.20 with this paragraph, the court may award actual damages, including any compensation owed  
1.21 under this section."

1.22 Page 4, delete line 8

1.23 Page 4, line 9, delete everything before "the" and insert "(b) Along with the civil action  
1.24 provided in paragraph (a),"

1.25 Page 4, line 10, delete "and" and insert ", injunctive relief, and any other relief the court  
1.26 finds just and equitable"

1.27 Page 4, after line 10, insert:

1.28 "(c) The attorney general may enforce subdivision 1 of this section, pursuant to section  
1.29 8.31, and may recover costs and fees."

1.30 "(d) This section does not affect a right or remedy available under any other law of the  
1.31 state."

(e) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to have any effect on a party that is neither

the content creator nor the minor who engaged in the work of content creation."


