1.10 Page 1, line 19, reinstate the stricken ", provided that the person"

1.11 Page 1, line 20, reinstate the stricken "provides a name and contact information, remains  
1.12 on the"

1.13 Page 1, line 21, reinstate the stricken language

1.14 And when so amended the bill do pass. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
