The bill expands the Good Samaritan immunity protections for those seeking emergency assistance for someone experiencing a drug-related overdose to include individuals acting in concert with the person who makes the emergency call, if they provide a name and contact information, remain at the scene until assistance arrives and cooperate with authorities.

Under current law, immunity is limited to the first person who seeks assistance for the individual experiencing the overdose.
