S.F. No. 4093 – Predatory Offender End-of-Confinement Review; Victim Notice and Input

Section 1 permits law enforcement agents and victims to submit written material that is relevant to a predatory offender's risk level to the chair of an end-of-confinement review committee. Requires the commissioner of corrections to provide notice of a predatory offender's risk level assignment to the victim, if requested.

Section 2 requires the commissioner of corrections to make a good faith effort to notify a victim of an end-of-confinement review process and of the victim's right to submit written input to the review committee, both at the initial review, as well as at any subsequent risk assessments reviews. Notice shall only be provided to victims who have submitted a written request to receive notice. Good faith efforts to notify the victim must occur before the offender's end-of-confinement review hearing.
