S.F. No. 3972 – Sales restrictions for aerosol dusters (as amended by the A-1)

S.F. 3972 defines “aerosol duster,” “behind-the-counter,” and “1,1-difluoroethane” (DFE). Retailers may only sell an aerosol duster that contains DFE from behind the counter to a purchaser who presents valid evidence that the purchaser is at least 21 years of age, and may not sell more than three cans of an aerosol duster to a single customer. The requirements do not apply to a business purchasing aerosol dusters online. Aerosol dusters sold in the state must conform to labeling requirements. A person who violates the requirements is guilty of a misdemeanor.
