Bill Overview

S.F. 4204 allows various ombudspersons to access the social service information system (SSIS) and requires the ombudspersons to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

Section Summaries

Section 1 (adds 3.9215, subd. 14) allows the Ombudsperson for American Indian Families, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson's duties. Requires the ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

Section 2 (amends 245.975, subd. 4) allows the Ombudsperson for Family Child Care Providers, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson's duties.

Section 3 (adds 257.0762, subd. 3) allows each Ombudsperson for Families, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson's duties. Requires each ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.

Section 4 (adds 260C.82, subd. 8) allows the Foster Youth Ombudsperson, or a designee, access to the SSIS as necessary for the discharge of the ombudsperson's duties. Requires the ombudsperson and designees to adhere to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act.
