Senator Gustafson and Representative Becker-Finn,

The Minneapolis Public Schools Board of Directors adopted the district's legislative agenda on January 9, 2024. The legislative agenda focuses primarily on education finance issues, however, the Board felt strongly that the district needs to speak up on the issue of gun violence and its impact on our students.

Minneapolis Public Schools supports House File 4300/Senate File 4312 and urges the Senate Judiciary and Public Safety Committee to pass the bill. Safely storing firearms will save the lives of our state's young people.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention released data on child and adolescent mortality showing deaths by firearms now outnumber deaths by motor vehicle crashes. More young people die by firearms than any other cause. Deaths by homicide have increased and deaths by suicide have increased.

With students reporting increased mental health concerns and increased suicidal ideation as reported on the Minnesota student survey, we cannot sit back and hope that guns in their homes are safely stored. We must act. The safe storage requirements in House File 4300/Senate File 4312 will keep guns out of the hands of children and will make our schools safer.
