Section 1 defines the terms "conservator," "guardian," and "power of attorney" for purposes of the statutes governing predatory offender registration.

Section 2 amends the methods the Bureau of Criminal Apprehension can use to verify that a person required to register as a predatory offender is living at an address in a new state and allows the bureau to determine if the evidence is sufficient to confirm the person's new residence.

Section 3 authorizes the guardian or conservator for, or power of attorney of, a person required to register as a predatory offender to complete all verification and registration paperwork on behalf of the person.
