- 1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS5153A-1)
- 1.2 to S.F. No. 5153 as follows:
- 1.3 Page 3, after line 11, insert:
- 1.4 "Subd. 4. Affirmative defense. If proven by a preponderance of the evidence, it is an
- 1.5 affirmative defense to a violation of this section that the defendant committed the violation
- 1.6 only under compulsion by the transferee, who by explicit or implicit threats or other acts
- 1.7 created a reasonable apprehension in the mind of the defendant that the refusal of the
- 1.8 defendant to participate in the violation would result in the transferee causing substantial
- 1.9 bodily harm or death to the defendant."
- 1.10 Amend the title accordingly
