delete everything after "walkthrough" and insert "of"
Page 1, line 27, delete "to" and delete "have occurred"
Page 1, line 28, after "schools" insert "and law enforcement agencies"
Page 1, delete lines 30 and 31 and insert:
"(d) At the conclusion of work completed pursuant to a grant under this section, the
board must deliver all data created, collected, or maintained under this section to the school
without payment, and in a manner that the school may own, control, use, and access the
data without limitation. The data must be provided in a form that permits the school to share
the data with a law enforcement agency."
