

1.1 **Senator McEwen from the Committee on Labor, to which was referred**

1.2 **S.F. No. 3496:** A bill for an act relating to labor; providing compensation for minors
1.3 appearing in Internet content creation; amending Minnesota Statutes 2022, sections 181A.03,
1.4 by adding subdivisions; 181A.07, subdivision 2; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota
1.5 Statutes, chapter 181A.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 1, line 17, delete "in exchange for" and insert "that generates"

1.8 Page 1, line 21, delete "video"

1.9 Page 1, line 22, delete "in exchange for" and insert "that generates"

1.10 Page 2, line 2, delete everything after the period

1.11 Page 2, delete line 3

1.12 Page 2, line 8, delete "181A.117" and insert "181A.13"

1.13 Page 2, lines 12 and 15, delete "video"

1.14 Page 2, line 17, delete "per video segment"

1.15 Page 2, line 19, delete "video" and delete "\$0.10" and insert "\$0.01"

1.16 Page 2, line 20, delete "video"

1.17 Page 3, lines 9, 13, and 17, delete "video"

1.18 Page 4, after line 13, insert:

1.19 "Subd. 5. **Content deletion requests.** (a) A person 13 years of age or older who was
1.20 featured as a minor child in content of a content creator may request the permanent deletion
1.21 of the content from an online platform. An online platform must have an easily accessible
1.22 form available online for submission of the deletion request.

1.23 (b) An online platform that receives a deletion request shall remove and permanently
1.24 delete the content for which the request was made within seven days after the request was
1.25 submitted.

1.26 (c) Any contract between a content creator and an online platform that would reasonably
1.27 be anticipated to feature a minor child must include notification to the social media platform
1.28 of the rights under this subdivision.

1.29 Subd. 6. **Minimum age exemption.** A minor compensated under this section is exempt
1.30 from the minimum age provisions of section 181A.04, subdivision 1."
