**Bill Description**

The bill adds well designers certified in Minnesota to the list of persons authorized to design the potable water pipe from well head to pressure tank. Other authorized designers include engineers licensed in the state of Minnesota and master plumbers licensed in the state of Minnesota.

**Assumptions**

The bill would permit water well contractors to submit and the agency to accept plumbing plan review forms submitted by water well contractors for water pipe installations from a well head to the pressure tank. DLI assumes this change only impacts who is authorized to submit these plans and will not impact the volume of plumbing plan reviews the agency receives. Because DLI already reviews/approves these installation designs, no additional staff time will be required.
