Section 1. [181.536] POSTING OF VETERANS' BENEFITS AND SERVICES.

Subdivision 1. Poster creation; content. (a) The commissioner shall consult with the

commissioner of veterans affairs to create and distribute a veterans' benefits and services

poster.

(b) The poster must, at a minimum, include information regarding the following benefits

and services available to veterans:

(1) contact and website information for the Department of Veterans Affairs and the

department's veterans' services program;

(2) substance use disorder and mental health treatment;

(3) educational, workforce, and training resources;

(4) tax benefits;

(5) Minnesota state veteran drivers' licenses and state identification cards;

(6) eligibility for unemployment insurance benefits under state and federal law;

(7) legal services; and

(8) contact information for the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Veterans Crisis

- 2.1 (c) The commissioner must annually review the poster's content and update the poster
2.2 to include the most current information available.
- 2.3 Subd. 2. **Mandatory posting.** Every employer in the state with more than 50 full-time
2.4 equivalent employees shall display the poster created pursuant to this section in a conspicuous
2.5 place accessible to employees in the workplace.
