## **S.F. No. 4298 – Electric vehicle charging infrastructure at certain new residential buildings**

**S.F. 4298** amends the State Building Code to require electric vehicle charging capability within or adjacent to new residential buildings that provide on-site parking facilities. Currently, electric vehicle charging is only required at commercial and multifamily structures, and residential structures with fewer than four dwellings are exempt.
