Dear Senator Champion,

A continuance has been granted in the criminal case of Senator Mitchell, due to her counsel being unavailable as a result of their litigation of an ongoing and unrelated trial in another county. Senator Mitchell's omnibus hearing originally scheduled for June 10, 2024, is now scheduled for July 1, 2024. As a result, there are no significant updates or new information to present at this time.

While the July 1, 2024 Omnibus hearing may substantially advance the criminal case, there is effectively no chance that the matter will be resolved at that point. It is my experience that a case of this scope takes at least several months to reach a resolution. I envision this matter being litigated into fall 2024.

We understand and respect the committee's authority and procedures. It is our expectation that this correspondence will be provided to the other members of the subcommittee.
