1.5	17.1 In case of a disturbance or disorderly conduct in the lobbies or galleries, the President

1.7	17.2 A member may not introduce a visitor or visitors in the galleries from the floor or rostrum
1.8	of the Senate.
1.9	17.3 Smoking is not permitted in the Senate Chamber or galleries, the Retiring Room, hearing
1.10	rooms, offices, or other spaces under the control of the Senate.
1.11	17.4 During floor proceedings, picture taking by persons other than accredited news or
1.12	legislative photographers, picture taking with floodlights or flash units, and visual or audible
1.13	disruptions are prohibited.
1.14	17.5 Demonstrations are prohibited in the Senate Chamber and galleries at all times.
1.15	17.6 At all times, demonstrations and food or beverages are prohibited in the Senate Chamber
1.16	and in the galleries, except that when floor proceedings are expected to last more than one hour,
1.17	members of the Senate and Senate staff may consume water in the Senate Chamber. Water that is
1.18	not being consumed must be stored out of sight in a sealed, unadorned container under a member's

1.20	17.5 17.7 Television recording or broadcasting on the Senate floor is under the direction of
1.21	the Secretary.
