- and must purchase all supplies, equipment, and other goods and services necessary to carry out the work of the Senate. Any contracts in excess of \$...... must be approved by the Chair of the Committee

- 2.4 for termination of the contract or withdrawal of the Senate as party to the contract, the Chair or the
- 2.5 minority leader may notify the Secretary, in writing, that the Chair or minority leader intends to
