1.6	15.2 A person may not be admitted to the Senate Chamber except as provided in these rules.
1.7	A member, an officer, the constitutional officers, ex-Governors of the State of Minnesota, members
1.8	of the House, judges of the trial and appellate courts and members of Congress and Senate staff
1.9	may be admitted.
1.10	15.3 The constitutional officers, ex-Governors of the State of Minnesota, members of the
1.11	House of Representatives, judges of the trial and appellate courts, and members of Congress may
1.12	be personally admitted by a member of the Senate. Past members of Congress or of the state
1.13	legislature who are not interested in any claim or directly in a bill pending before the legislature
1.14	may be personally admitted by a member of the Senate.
1.15	15.4 An employee of either house the House of Representatives may be personally admitted
1.16	at the request of a member or an officer of the Senate.
1.17	15.5 A member of another state, provincial, or national legislative body may be personally
1.18	admitted to the floor by any member of the Senate. A member of another legislative body who is
1.19	personally admitted to the floor may be introduced to the Senate by the President.
1.20	15.6 The President may designate and personally admit the person who will provide the
1.21	prayer and the person who will lead the Pledge of Allegiance.
1.22	15.7 When the Senate is not meeting, a person who is not a member may be admitted to the
1.23	floor at the request of a member or an officer.
