- 1.6 of the committee or subcommittee, the bill or bills to be considered, and the place and time of
- 1.7 meeting. The notice must be posted on the Senate's Web site and on all Senate bulletin boards in
- 1.8 the Capitol and the State Office Building. A notice must be sent to the House of Representatives
- 1.9 for posting as it deems necessary. ~~If the three-day notice requirement cannot be met, the committee~~
- 1.10 ~~or subcommittee shall give simultaneous notice to all of the known proponents and opponents of~~
- 1.11 ~~the bill as soon as practicable~~ Bills may be removed from a schedule with less than 72 hours notice.
- 1.12 Upon agreement between the chair of the committee and the ranking minority member of the
- 1.13 committee, items may be added to the agenda with less than 72 hours notice.
