- 1.3 Temporary Senate Rule No. 40.8 is amended to read:
- 1.4 40.8 When permissible under Rule 40.7, a member may authorize a designee chosen by the
- 1.5 respective caucus leader to vote on the member's behalf while the member is at a location outside
- 1.6 of the Senate chamber. When a member assigns the member's vote to a designee under this rule,
- 1.7 the designee shall vote on the member's behalf as directed by the member on each question. The
- 1.8 Secretary may adopt procedures to ensure the accurate and efficient administration of this rule. The
- 1.9 Rules and Administration Committee must review and approve the procedures adopted by the
- 1.10 Secretary within 30 days of commencement of each biennial session. If the procedures are not
- 1.11 adopted, the Secretary must cease using the procedures unless or until they are approved by the
- 1.12 Rules and Administration Committee.
