S.F. No. 3564 – Sales tax exemption for safety devices for firearms

This bill amends the sales tax exemption for firearm storage units to include safety devices. “Safety device” means a device that, when installed on a firearm, is designed to prevent the firearm from being operated without first deactivating the device. The bill also adds safety devices to the prohibition in that exemption on sellers from collecting or transmitting data or information about a purchase of a firearm storage unit. Effective for sales and purchases made after June 30, 2023.
