# TAX EXEMPTION FOR WATER TOWER



### **PUBLIC PURPOSE**

To construct a second water tower to provide residents, businesses, and visitors with adequate water services, and maintain adequate fire protection throughouht the region.

## WHAT IS THE CITY SEEKING?

The City has taken emergency action to conserve water to ensure it meets potential public safety demands. However, with all of these measures in-place, the City still needs to construct a second water tower to meet demand. As a City of under 5,000 residents, we are seeking financial support by way of tax exemption for construction materials. These materials are largely concrete and steel, and are expected to total \$2M in material cost alone. The City is also currently constructing a \$25M wastewater treatment facility expansion, and tax exemption for the project would go a long way to benefit the businesses, residents, and members of the regional fire district in funding this project.
