BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **DEPREDATION PAYMENTS; APPROPRIATION.**

(a) \$..... in fiscal year 2026 and \$..... in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the

general fund to the commissioner of agriculture for compensation payments under Minnesota

Statutes, section 3.737, for livestock destroyed or crippled by wolves. If the amount in the

first year is insufficient, the amount in the second year is available in the first year. The

commissioner may use up to \$5,000 of this appropriation each year to reimburse expenses

1.10

incurred by university extension agents to provide fair market values of destroyed or crippled

1.11

livestock.
