Dear Chair Putnam and members of the committee:

On behalf of Minnesota Farmers Union (MFU), I write to thank you for your work to expand consumer access to higher blends of biofuels and to share our strong support for Senator Kupec's SF881 and Senator Dornink's SF1507. We believe these bills reflect an important opportunity to curtail carbon emissions, lower the price consumers pay at the pump, and strengthen an important market for many family farmers.

MFU is a grassroots organization that has represented Minnesota's family farmers, ranchers, and rural communities since 1918. Our members support expanding the use of higher-octane, cleaner-burning biofuels, including through upgrading the infrastructure at fuel retailers across the state. We often hear from members who want to purchase E15 and higher blend fuels but can't find a service station that sells it near their home or business. Purchasing blended fuel is important to them not only because it saves them money, but also because they know that their dollars are going back into Minnesota's agriculture economy.

Even beyond lowering consumer prices and the benefits to our rural economy, improving consumer access to higher blend fuels through infrastructure upgrades will lower carbon emissions from our existing transportation fleet. This proposal is a win-win-win for consumers, rural communities, and the climate.
