

## S.F. No. 1935 – Prohibiting elective cat declawing

**SF 1935** prohibits elective declawing of cats by adding a new section 343.256 to chapter 343 relating to prevention of cruelty to animals.

**Subdivision 1** defines "cat," "declawing," "procedure performed solely for a therapeutic purpose," and "tendonectomy."

**Subdivision 2** prohibits surgical claw removal, declawing, and tendonectomy on cats except in certain circumstances.

**Subdivision 3** allows surgical claw removal, declawing, or tendonectomy when a procedure is performed solely for a therapeutic purpose.

**Subdivision 4** specifies civil penalties for violations of the section.
