RE: Support for Library Construction Grants

Chair Pappas and members of the Senate Capital Investment Committee,

On behalf of the Minnesota Library Association (MLA) and the Council of Regional Public Library System Administrators (CRPLSA), thank you for your strong support and advocacy for public libraries. In particular, thank you for your support of the Library Construction Grant program. As you are aware, public library buildings are a vital part of a community's social infrastructure. Currently, a need of over \$187M in renovation and construction projects has been identified across the state. In 2025, MLA is requesting \$10M in capital investment funding for the program with a cap of \$2M per grant to assist with these projects. Your support of bonding dollars for the construction and remodeling of public library buildings through the State's authorized matching program is essential in ensuring that all Minnesotans have access to safe, accessible, and welcoming spaces for education and enrichment.

Since 1995, over 150 library projects have benefited from the Library Construction Grant program. Grants ranging from \$3,000 to \$1M allowed for the renovation of current spaces, provided ADA accessibility, and completed new construction projects. Recently:

- By expanding a large meeting room and adding an outdoor space for performances, the Dakota County Library was able to boost the social and educational infrastructure of the Hastings community, made possible by a \$300,000 library construction grant for the Pleasant Hill Library in 2019.
- In 2021, a library construction grant of \$729,102 was awarded to the City of Howard Lake enabling the construction of a new, 7,000-square-foot library facility. Opening in August 2024, the new building replaced the previous two-story facility located a few blocks away, which had been in use since 1979, lacking handicap accessibility and dealing with continued issues with water intrusion. The new building is a net-zero facility generating energy on-site using clean renewable resources in a quantity equal to or greater than the total amount of energy consumed.



• The Mahnomen Public Library saw an increase in overall use following a \$28,750 construction grant awarded to the City of Mahnomen in 2022. The funding provided repairs to the roof and gutter system, replacement of stained ceiling tiles and 50 year-old windows, and the installation of energy efficient lighting. The repairs brought the charming 1937 WPA building back to life and offers community members a greater opportunity for enrichment, entertainment and community gathering.

Because the need is so great, and because investing in library infrastructure results in investment in Minnesota's communities, MLA strongly urges the Senate Capital Investment Committee to provide funding at the highest level of support.
