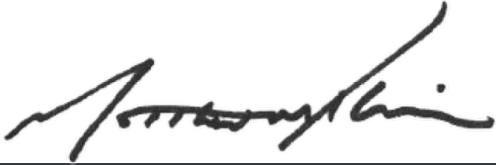
The A1 is adopted.
