

S.F. No. 864 – Third-party Delivery Service Liquor License

S.F. 864 requires third-party delivery services to obtain a third-party delivery off-sale liquor license.

The bill requires third-party delivery services to pay an annual fee of \$500 to obtain a license to deliver alcohol.

Employees of third-party delivery services must be 21 years of age in order to deliver alcoholic beverages. Employees delivering alcohol must verify that recipients of alcohol are 21 years of age. Employees must complete alcoholic beverages awareness training.

A third-party delivery licensee must obtain liquor liability insurance under section 340A.409.
