



S.F. No. 1481 – Skin-lightener Signage Required

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S.F. 1481 requires retailers who sell skin-lightening products to display a sign in plain view that provides notice that selling skin-lightening products that contain mercury is illegal. The display must also disclose that using skin-lightening products that contain mercury may result in adverse health consequences.

The commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency and the commissioner of health must work with community-based organizations to develop the required signage.
