

1.1 **Senator Klein from the Committee on Commerce and Consumer Protection, to**
1.2 **which was referred**

1.3 **S.F. No. 1054:** A bill for an act relating to health insurance; requiring coverage of
1.4 vasectomies by health plans; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 62Q.522,
1.5 subdivision 1.

1.6 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill be amended as follows:

1.7 Page 2, after line 12, insert:

1.8 "Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 256B.0625, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.9 to read:

1.10 Subd. 77. **Vasectomies.** (a) Medical assistance covers vasectomies.

1.11 (b) Medical assistance must meet the requirements with respect to coverage of
1.12 vasectomies that would otherwise apply to a health plan under section 62Q.522, except that
1.13 medical assistance is not required to comply with any provision of section 62Q.522 if
1.14 compliance with the provision would:

1.15 (1) prevent the state from receiving federal financial participation for the coverage under
1.16 this subdivision;

1.17 (2) result in a lower level of coverage or reduced access to coverage for medical assistance
1.18 enrollees; or

1.19 (3) violate Code of Federal Regulations, title 42, part 441, subpart F.

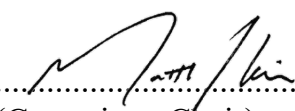
1.20 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2026, or upon federal approval,
1.21 whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor of statutes
1.22 when federal approval is obtained."

1.23 Amend the title as follows:

1.24 Page 1, line 2, after the second semicolon, insert "requiring the medical assistance
1.25 program and MinnesotaCare to cover vasectomies;"

1.26 Amend the title numbers accordingly

1.27 And when so amended the bill do pass and be re-referred to the Committee on Health
1.28 and Human Services. Amendments adopted. Report adopted.
