Chair Klein and Members of the Committee,

The City of Minneapolis supports SF 1182, which provides authorization for cities to issue social district licenses. The City of Minneapolis' 2025 Legislative Agenda includes support for the expansion of local authority for cities to create social districts. Allowing cities to determine whether and how to create these districts will supply another tool to activate portions of our communities in new and creative ways.

Current law, which allows for a select few cities to create social districts, has shown positive results and is an ideal model to expand to cities across Minnesota. Local leaders are ready to engage with residents and small business entrepreneurs about the most effective means to activate their unique communities. If this tool is deemed appropriate, then SF 1182 will allow for the implementation of social districts for the benefit of Minnesota residents and guests.
