1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 12a. **Transfers of wine.** Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision 12, the

1.9holder of an off-sale intoxicating liquor license may transfer wine from one licensed premises

1.10to another provided that:

1.11(1) the license for the transferring and receiving premises are held by the same licensee;

1.12(2) the licensee notifies the wholesaler from whom the wine was purchased and the

1.13Division of Alcohol and Gambling Enforcement of the Division of Public Safety, in writing,

1.14of the transfer; and

1.15(3) only one transfer is made from a licensed premises in a three-month period.

1.16**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
