



S.F. No. 1865 – Food Truck License

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S.F. 1865 establishes a food truck license for the sale of intoxicating liquor. Food truck means a business that is licensed or permitted by the licensing authority to prepare and sell food from a motorized vehicle or trailer within the municipality.

A municipality may issue a temporary license to a food truck for the sale of intoxicating liquor at a community festival or event, or a private event that the food truck has entered into a contract with a person to cater.

The license must specify the conditions under which the liquor must be dispensed and consumed. The licensee must have liability insurance as prescribed by section 340A.409 to cover the event.

A licensee is subject to the terms imposed by the issuing municipality.

Prior to any community festival or event or private catered event, the licensee shall notify the police chief of the city where the event will take place or the county sheriff of the county where the event will take place.
