

S.F. No. 2221 – Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota Liquor License Modifications

S.F. 2221 makes modifications to the liquor licenses held by the Board of Regents of the University of Minnesota.

Section 1 allows the commissioner of public safety to issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to an entity holding a concessions contract with the Board of Regents. The limitation of seven locations is removed, and there is a requirement that the locations be described within the license applications.

Licenses may be issued for a space that is not compact and contiguous, provided that the space is described in the license application.

Section 2 removes the prohibition against issuing a license to sell intoxicating liquor on the campus of the College of Agriculture of the University of Minnesota.
