Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 340A.412, subdivision 10, is amended to

Subd. 10. **Employment of minors.** No person under 18 years of age may ~~serve or~~ sell

intoxicating liquor in a retail ~~intoxicating liquor~~ establishment that has an off-sale intoxicating

liquor license. A person 17 years of age may serve or sell intoxicating liquor in a retail

establishment that has an on-sale intoxicating liquor license.
