

1.1 Senator moves to amend the delete-everything amendment (SCS2216A-6)
1.2 to S.F. No. 2216 as follows:

1.3 Page 71, after line 12, insert:

1.4 "Sec. 5. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 216B.40, is amended to read:

1.5 **216B.40 EXCLUSIVE SERVICE RIGHT; SERVICE EXTENSION.**

1.6 Except as provided in sections 216B.42 ~~and~~, 216B.421, and 216B.422, each electric
1.7 utility shall have the exclusive right to provide electric service at retail to each and every
1.8 present and future customer in its assigned service area and no electric utility shall render
1.9 or extend electric service at retail within the assigned service area of another electric utility
1.10 unless the electric utility consents thereto in writing; provided that any electric utility may
1.11 extend its facilities through the assigned service area of another electric utility if the extension
1.12 is necessary to facilitate the electric utility connecting its facilities or customers within its
1.13 own assigned service area.

1.14 Sec. 6. **[216B.422] ELECTRICITY SALES FOR CHARGING ELECTRIC**
1.15 **VEHICLES.**

1.16 A retail seller of electricity used to recharge a battery that powers an electric vehicle, as
1.17 defined in section 169.011, subdivision 26a, and that is not otherwise a public utility under
1.18 this chapter, is not in violation of section 216B.40 if the electricity the retailer sells was
1.19 provided by the utility serving the location of the charging station."
