# Minnesota P-20 Education Partnership: 2024-2025 Highlights

#### Statutory Language

• Minn. Stat. 127A.20 (first codified in 2009):

A P-20 education partnership is established to **create a seamless system of education that maximizes achievements of all students, from early childhood through elementary, secondary, and postsecondary education, while promoting the efficient use of financial and human resources.** The partnership shall consist of major statewide educational groups or constituencies or noneducational statewide organizations with a stated interest in P-20 education.

- The statute also includes additional language outlining legislative representation on the partnership, powers and duties, and key areas of focus.
- Our take on this work as an intermediary organization: Not seamless, but building stronger seams (and/or: we are the seams)

MNP20 is a multi-sector, independent coalition of leaders representing early childhood, K-12, higher education, nonprofits, workforce development, and government. Partnership members collaborate to influence change, foster innovation, and advocate for policies affecting learner success and outcomes from birth through workforce.

- Currently 26 voting member organizations, agencies, institutions, and legislators
- Led by an Executive Committee (current chair, OHE Commissioner Olson; current vice chair, MDE Deputy Commissioner Graff) and an Executive Director
- Funding provided through private philanthropy and the support of multiple MNP20 partners
- Executive Director is based at the MN Office of Higher Education
- SLEDS and ECLDS fall under our statutory umbrella as well
