# MINNESOTA CHARTERED PUBLIC SCHOOL FACTS

#### ✓ Charter Schools are Public Schools

#### ✓ Charter Schools are Tuition Free

### ✓ Charter Schools are Open to All;

- → Cannot require entrance exams or requirements;
- → Cannot limit the admission of pupils on the basis of intellectual ability, measures of achievement or aptitude, or athletic ability;
- → Must accept all students up to capacity;
- → Must conduct a lottery if there are more students than slots.

## √ Special Education

→ Charter schools follow the same federal and state requirements to provide special education services as other public school districts.

#### ✓ Teachers

→ All charter school teachers must hold a valid MN teaching license.

### ✓ Audits

→ Charter schools follow the same financial audits, audit procedures, and audit requirements as traditional public school districts.

### ✓ Minnesota's charter schools are subject to:

- → Human Rights Law;
- → Pupil Fair Dismissal Act;
- → Public School Fee Law;
- → Data Practices Law;
- → General Employment Law;
- → Federal, state, and local health and safety laws;
- → State testing requirements;
- → ...and other laws and requirements.
