

## S.F. No. 16 – Physical and Sexual Abuse Education

Section 1. **Required academic standards.** Requires a school district to include child physical and sexual abuse prevention instruction in a health curriculum. Requires the instruction to include multisession, multimodal, culturally inclusive, developmentally appropriate, and culturally sensitive instruction on identifying emotional and physical child abuse and other forms of personal violence. Allows a district to provide information to parents on the warning signs of child physical and sexual abuse, and the medical and emotional effects of child abuse. Requires a school district to train educators on managing disclosures that may result during the delivery of the instruction.

Sec. 2. **Purpose.** Amends "Erin's Law" to require districts to integrate or offer instruction on child sexual abuse prevention to students and training to school personnel on recognizing and preventing sexual abuse and sexual violence.

Sec. 3. **Curriculum.** Strikes reference to the Child Welfare Information Gateway website for districts to consult for abuse prevention tools.
