

S.F. No. 2250 – Hours of Educational Instruction

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Section 1. Length of School Year: Hours of Instruction.

Subd. 2. **Hours of instruction.** (a) Allows hours of instruction in secondary school to include educational experiences that:

- (1) allow students to earn academic credit;
- (2) are available to all enrolled students; and
- (3) are supervised, coordinated, and verified by a qualified teacher.
- (b) Allows experiences that are included in hours of instruction to:
 - (1) be included in any secondary school course of study prescribed by the school board; and
 - (2) occur outside the regular school day and week, but not outside the school year.
- (c) Prohibits the school district from denying student access to any service or instruction required under state or federal law.
- (d) Directs the department to regularly review and update its policies and structures, including reporting requirements, to ensure that they do not constrain districts from providing students with a range of educational opportunities available under this subdivision.
- (e) Clarifies that nothing in this subdivision modifies pupil units or provides additional pupil units for an educational experience included in hours of instruction.



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
