S.F. 600, as amended by the A-2 amendment, requires posted notice of absentee polling places. As soon as practicable and no later than 5 business days after a county auditor or municipal clerk designates an additional temporary absentee polling location, the auditor or clerk must post on the city or county's website the polling place's address and the dates and times the polling place will be open for voting. As soon as practicable and no later than 5 business days after receiving the notice of the additional polling places, the secretary of state must also post the same information on the secretary's website.
