1.2 **S.F. No. 1071:** A bill for an act relating to elections; providing for ranked choice voting;
1.3 authorizing jurisdictions to adopt ranked choice voting for local offices; establishing
1.4 procedures for adoption, implementation, and use of ranked choice voting for local
1.5 jurisdictions; allowing local jurisdictions to use electronic voting systems with a reallocation
1.6 feature; authorizing rulemaking; appropriating money; amending Minnesota Statutes 2024,
1.7 sections 204B.35, subdivision 1; 204C.21, by adding a subdivision; 204D.07, subdivision
1.8 3; 205.13, subdivision 2; 206.57, by adding a subdivision; 206.83; proposing coding for
1.9 new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 206; proposing coding for new law as Minnesota
1.10 Statutes, chapter 204E.

1.11 Reports the same back with the recommendation that the bill do pass and be re-referred
1.12 to the Committee on State and Local Government. Report adopted.
