



S.F. No. 1677 – Two-Year Revolving Door Prohibition for Legislators

Section 1 [Minn. Stat. 10A.035; Lobbyist restrictions] prohibits legislators from becoming lobbyists for two years after they leave legislative service. The Campaign Finance and Public Disclosure Board may impose a civil penalty of the lesser of \$25,000 or an amount equal to the amount equal to the amount the legislator earned as a lobbyist in violation of the law. This section is effective the day following final enactment and applies to legislators who leave legislative service on or after that date.
